MAJOR SERVICES

Each of the following services are available one time per plan year per account.

ACTION SERVICES

These services allow you to initiate the legal matter on behalf of your client.

ESTATE PLANNING

- Wills with or without ordinary trust provisions
- Codicils
- Power of Attorney(s)
- Living Wills

FAMILY LAW

- Adoption Court Proceedings
- Divorce, Annulment, or Modification of Existing Order - Six-month waiting period applies.
 - Modification of existing order (limited)
- Name Change

CIVIL LAW

- Consumer Protection
 - Deceptive Trade Practice Act

BANKRUPTCY

- Bankruptcy Court Proceedings
 - Chapter 7 and 13 only

PROTECTION SERVICES

These services allow you to defend or respond to the legal matter on behalf of your client.

CIVIL LAW

- Defense of Civil Action
 - Respondent or Defendant (non business)
 - Family law matters may also qualify

CRIMINAL LAW

- Driving While Intoxicated/Driving Under the Influence
- Felony Charge
- Habeas Corpus Court Proceedings
- Insanity or Infirmity Proceeding
- Juvenile Court Proceedings
 - Family coverage required
- Misdemeanor Charge
 - Does not apply to traffic violations, disturbing the peace, and intoxication.
- Misdemeanor Charge - License Suspension - The action leads to suspension or revocation of license
 - Does not apply to traffic violations, disturbing the peace, and intoxication.

PREVENTATIVE LEGAL SERVICES

Under this category an additional four (4) hours per plan year are available for legal advice, correspondence, negotiation and document preparation. TLPP members may use this time for legal matters not included in the major services categories.

EXCLUSIONS

1. Any action brought in Small Claims Court.
2. Any action or proceeding between a Participant and his or her employer, fellow members, the Policyholder, TLPP or its agents, or labor management trust fund.
3. Any legal proceeding in which the Participant is the plaintiff, petitioner or movant, with the exception of the Bankruptcy; Divorce, Annulment or Separation; Adoption; Consumer Protection and the Name Change coverages.
4. Appeal proceedings.
5. Class actions, interventions and amicus curiae filings.
6. Costs other than the amount charged by an attorney for his/her time spent providing covered legal services. An example of these costs would be filing fees, reporter fees, court costs, etc.
7. Duplication of services previously claimed and in relation to the same matter in the same benefit year.
8. Matters arising out of any business interest, business transaction, business pursuit, profession, partnership or corporation.
9. Matters for which a contingency fee is customarily charged, and probate, workmen's compensation and similar matters in which a fee is normally allowed.
10. Matters relating to patents or copyrights.
11. Preparing, completing or filing Federal, State or Local tax returns.
12. Proceedings in which Participant is entitled to legal representation or reimbursement for costs thereof from any source other than this policy.
13. To anyone except the Named Participant in any type proceeding in which the interest of any Participant is opposed to the interest of the Named Participant.
